Social Initiatives

Many people still talk but we want to inform you all that we no longer have an NGO. Since August 2020 we have completely shut down our organization (NGO) and we have decided to fund all our ongoing social work ourselves. This decision of the CEO, Mandeep Kaur Sidhu has filled her and her business team with even more enthusiasm. She is proud and relieved that we are running the mission of distributing 50,000 shoes smoothly because of the business profitability of our team and company. In November we completed the 385th Camp of the 50,000 Shoe Distribution Mission.

Some social activities for the month of November:

1. Shoe Giving Campaign

It is winter, and children are in dire need of shoes. Often children living in slums do not have weather-friendly facilities. Shoes were distributed to needy children of Beas slums this month. Our 50,000 shoe giving target has reached 18,409.



2. Contributions to the new sewing training center

The inauguration ceremony of the new sewing training center for girls opened by Malaudh Youth Group was funded by SimbaQuartz. We are happy that such an initiative will help more women to become self-reliant and open their own businesses. We always support initiatives that encourage hard work & dedication.



3. Ration

Sanjeev Kumar, a resident of village Tangra, has lost his job due to the lockdown. At home he is the sole breadwinner and supports his family. Arriving at our office, he told us that there was no ration at home and that he had been struggling to make ends meet for the past few days. Checking their condition, SimbaQuartz provided immediate ration and financial assistance.

4. Library

The library of our company, SimbaQuartz, is a center of attraction in the village Tangra. We always try to have books on every subject so that people of every class can read them. Books for aspirants who are preparing for UPSC, CSE and many other subjects are included in the book house.



5. Financial Aid

The son of Bhajan Kaur of village Tangra, Amritsar died in a road accident. Bhajan Kaur is living with her daughter-in-law and 2 grandchildren, there is no one to earn in the family. Bhajan Kaur is elderly, her daughter-in-law is physically handicapped and both the children are young. Our team promises financial support to them every month and this month too they have been financially supported.

6. Distribution of winter cloths

SimbaQuartz donated winter clothes to Ram Singh and other needy children.

7. Education

Kulwinder Kaur, Gurpreet Kaur, Upasana and Varinder Singh come to SimbaQuartz. They are being given special computer courses training for free. Separate computers have been provided for them. Our aim is to support the young generation of the village who prioritize education and who want to learn in any way possible and to help them get a job in the near future. All four children are learning Web Development absolutely free from our professional teachers.

The evening school is closed for some time keeping in mind the prevailing situation and the health of the children. Children can still call at any time to get information about the education from our team.
