Social Initiatives

May the new year bring happiness to all. Although the experience of the year 2020 was very different for everyone, our social service activities remained the same as always. The only difference is that the organization has closed down completely since August and social work is going on in full swing. The mission to distribute 50,000 shoes has reached 18409. It was great to be part of the peasant struggle with the team in December.

Some social activities of December month:

1. Shoe Giving Campaign

In the month of December, it starts to get foggy, the sunshine also seems to be less. In such cold weather, needy children need shoes very much. Even in schools, children often do not have weather-friendly facilities. This month we distributed shoes to school children affiliated with "Hamari Kaksha" NGO in Panchkula and to needy children in Guru Nanak Khalsa girls school in Hoshiarpur district. Our distribution of 50,000 shoes mission has reached 18409.



2. Farmers Stir

Not only Delhi, but we have also been cooperating with the farmers since the month of June, July when the anti-farmer black laws were being opposed in Punjab. Realizing the duty, he went to Delhi on December 11 and became part of the peasant struggle. We had the opportunity to collaborate on water service with a Humanitarian Service Society. Apart from this, financial service was rendered to the entire Kisan Union on the land of Delhi as a mark of respect.



3. School Fees

Gursanyog Singh and Gurmilap Singh's school fees are paid by our company SimbaQuartz.

4. Beds/Quilts for girls wedding

The Mata Gujar Kaur Welfare Society, an organization that arranges marriages for needy girls from Khadur Sahib, approached us for help. To be a part of this noble cause we provided beds/quilts support to 3 girls.



5. Monthly Financial Help

The son of Bhajan Kaur of village Tangra, Amritsar was killed in a road accident. Bhajan Kaur is living with her daughter-in-law and 2 grandchildren, there is no one to earn in the family. Bhajan Kaur is elderly, her daughter-in-law is physically handicapped and both the children are young. Our team has promised financial support every month and this month too they have been financially supported.



6. Art

Along with education and health, we are also giving great importance to art. For a long time now we have been imparting acting training to aspiring children in our area. Like "Zindagi" and "Pencil" movies, a movie called "Janmadin" was released this month. Through this short film, our aim is to give good education and awareness to society and bring out the skills of the children.

Also in SimbaQuartz we have Gurpreet Kaur, Upasana, Varinder Singh and Ram Singh. Who are being given special computer courses absolutely free. Separate computers have been provided for them. Our aim is to support the young generation of the village who prefer education and those who want to learn in any way possible and to make them employable. All four children are learning Web Development absolutely free from our team.

The evening school is closed for some time due to the situation and the health of the children. Children can still call at any time to get information about schooling.
